### MUSEUM HOURS

Daily, 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.  
Extended summer hours from Memorial Day through  
Labor Day, 9:30 a.m. – 6 p.m.  
The Museum is closed on Thanksgiving Day,  
Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

### GENERAL ADMISSION

Admission is \$21 for adults, \$18 for seniors, college  
students and active or retired military with ID on site, and  
\$13 for children ages 6 and up. Children ages 5 and under  
are free. All tickets are valid for two consecutive days.
