MUSEUM HOURS

Daily, 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.
Extended summer hours from Memorial Day through
Labor Day, 9:30 a.m. – 6 p.m.
The Museum is closed on Thanksgiving Day,
Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

GENERAL ADMISSION

Admission is \$19 for adults, \$17 for seniors, college
students and active or retired military with ID on site,
\$12 for children ages 6 and up. Children ages 5 and under
are free. All tickets are valid for two consecutive days.

a timed ticket in advance is encouraged to guarantee
a preferred time slot.

Guided Highlights Tour *Daily at 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.*
Price of admission plus \$12

A 60-minute guided tour of the Museum's key artifacts
and stories. Limited to 15 people. Book online or at
the museum.
